'Karibu' (pronounced 'Kareeboo') means 'Welcome' in East African Swahili, and is the reply to 'Hodi' which is called out when asking to enter. The name reflects my Kenyan origins, and I welcome you to No8, Knysna Quays.

Whether you have come to us through a local Agent, SAGA Holidays, other Marketing Forum, or by personal recommendation, we hope your stay here is a delight. If you have any concerns or need any help or advice during your stay please let me know so that I can help; I only live 200 metres away! I would like to meet you anyway once you have settled in, and would be happy give you a quick induction to the Apartment.

You will have collected one set of Keys from the Security Gate which will have the No 8 Garage Door Remote on it; the second set will be on the hook inside the main door. When you check out, please leave the main Set with the Security Guard.

There are often neighbours above, beside and opposite 'Karibu', so I would be grateful if you would respect their peace and privacy whilst enjoying your stay at the Quays, by keeping noise levels reasonable, especially between 10pm and 8am.

Rubbish should be put in the big refuse bags and left outside your gate before 10am on Mondays and Thursdays (any recycling is done at the Rubbish Dump so everything goes together) - glass bottles may be left outside in boxes.

You will find instructions for the TV, DSTV, Hi-Fi/CD/DVD, and all other electrical equipment in a folder; plus a variety of other information which you may find interesting or informative. There are books for you to read and enjoy, - do feel free to swap any fiction ones for yours, but please leave the Travel Guides etc (which are marked) behind for others to enjoy. There are also CDs and DVDs for you to play, but please don't remove these either.

In the left hand Hall table drawer is a 'Top-Up' South African Mobile Phone (Cell) for your use whilst here. Please leave at least as much Credit in it as you found left on it.

You will find a 'Weber' Bar-b-Cue (Braai) outside, - please take sensible fire precautions when using it. There is also a double Canoe by the Jetty for you to use at your own risk; we have provided life-jackets too, which are not mandatory, but are recommended.

There are very few 'No-Nos!', but the Speed Limit of 10kph is strictly enforced, and Cars may only be parked in Garages or Bays (other than quick loading/unloading.) Please don't smoke cigarettes etc in the Apartment, - use the Patio (Stoep) instead, - but no butts in the pretty Lagoon please!

There is plenty of hot water, - if it does go warm, it won't take long to reheat. The bathroom extractor fans should be left on all the time to prevent damp; you may find that two flushes of the loos are required.....the dramatic flush does not reflect the efficiency!

Finally, please be aware that whilst every effort has been made and precaution taken for you to have a wonderful visit, the apartment is used at your own risk, and the Landlord cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury suffered during your occupancy.
